Mr. Caroline serves as Associate Professor at Pacific University College of Optometry in Forest Grove Oregon. He is a Fellow member and Diplomat of the Cornea and Contact Lens Section of the American Academy of Optometry. Patrick is a Council member of the International Society for Contact Lens Research as well as a member of the International Association of Contact Lens Educators and the American Association of Optometric Educators.

For the past sixteen years Patrick has served as a contributing editor for the Contact Lens Spectrum and is on the editorial board for Contact Lens and Anterior Eye Journal. He has published over 300 papers on a wide range of contact lens topics and has lectured extensively throughout the world.

He has primarily been involved in fitting specialty contact lenses and instructing both Ophthalmology and Optometry Residents on this subject since 1979. Mark is a Fellow member of the Cornea and Contact Lens Section of the American Academy of Optometry. He is also a Fellow member of the Contact Lens Society of America and a past board member of the society. In the past he served as chairman of the board for the National Contact Lens Examiners.

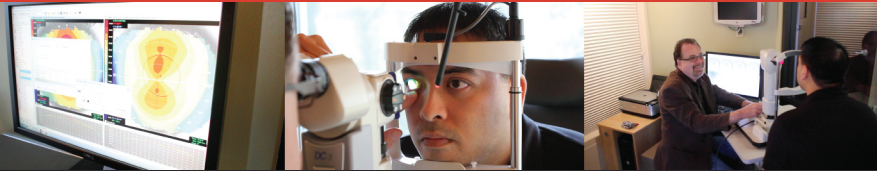
