Travel to Canada

Visitors who are U.S. Residents need passports.

Although visitors who are U.S. residents do not need a passport or visa to enter Canada, to RE-ENTER the United States, the Departments of State and Homeland Security require that citizens of the United States, Canada, Mexico and Bermuda must present a passport to enter the United States when arriving by air, boat or car from any part of the Western Hemisphere.
