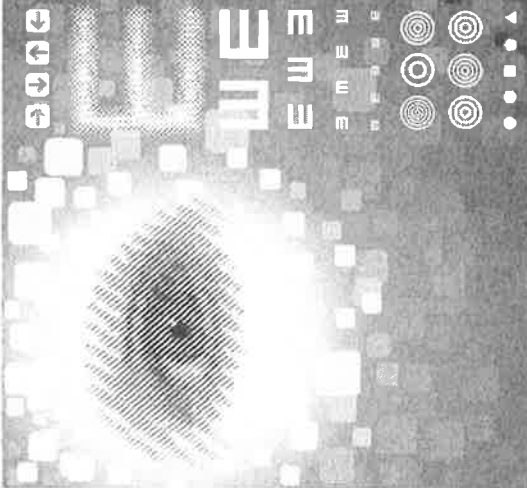

## ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Seventeen COPE-Approved, hours plus 1 hour of Non Cope Jurisprudence for a total of 18 hours of Continuing Education (CE) plus "CPR Recertification" will be offered. Additionally an Exhibit Hall with over 40 vendors will be on-site.

One low conference fee covers CE Registration and all Registration Materials, Continental Breakfast, Lunch and AM & PM Breaks on Saturday and Sunday.

Significant reduction in the conference fee for early registration (fee paid) on or before September 23, 2016. \*Additional Fee is required for CPR Recertification class and not subject to discount. To qualify for GOA Member rate, you must be a member in good standing as of 8/15/2016.

The UGA Hotel and Conference Center Registration Desk will be open a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the first lecture of each day and will remain open until the last lecture of the day begins.

Valid name badges will serve as tickets to the conference and must be worn by attendees for admission in the lecture hall. If the attendee is absent for more than 10 minutes, his/her name badge will not be returned until the end of the lecture, and he/she will not receive credit for that course. However, he/she will be allowed back into the lecture hall.
