A Focus on Low Vision Care



Dr. Richard Shuldiner Low Vision Optometry of Southern California

Richard J. Shuldiner, OD, F.A.A.O., founded the International Academy of Low Vision Specialists in 2006.

Dr. Shuldiner received his Doctor of Optometry degree from Pennsylvania College of Optometry in 1970. In 1975, he was certified in low vision by the New York State Optometric Association. In 1988, he became the 41st Low Vision Diplomate from the American Academy of Optometry.

Dr. Shuldiner is Clinical Director of Low Vision Optometry of Southern California with offices in the counties of Riverside, Orange, Los Angeles, San Diego, San Bernardino and Kern counties. He created and was clinical director of the Westchester Lighthouse Low Vision Clinic in New York, and was also assistant professor of ophthalmology at New York Medical College.

Dr. Shuldiner has lectured on low vision care to eye professionals in Russia, China, Hong Kong, Africa, and throughout the United States. Dr. Shuldiner trains doctors of optometry to add low vision care to their practice.

The late movie star Jane Russell, who suffered from macular degeneration, sought help from Dr. Shuldiner in 2007, for reading, watching television and movies, and recognizing faces.
