I, Inv. Brian Hibbs

attest to the following and state:

On 11-18-2015, Kotzebue AST was advised by the Maniilaq Health Clinic ER of the death of L.C. (16 year old female) in the local option village of Selawik.

The Village of Selawik is a local option community which prohibits the importation and sale of alcohol as voted on by the community on 12-17-1986.

At approximately 1130 hours, Kotzebue WAANT and Kotzebue AST arrived in Selawik. I contacted the Health Aides, Krystal Ballot and Jenny Hingbergen. Ballot stated at approximately 0052 hours, the Selawik Clinic received a call from Brent Norton who stated someone was at Ada and Butch Snyder's residence who was not breathing, choking on vomit, and cold. Ballot recognized the call as coming from the Selawik Police Office. Ballot, Hingbergen, and VPO Snyder arrived at the residence at approximately 0100 hours and located L.C., who was not breathing and did not have a pulse, on a bedroom floor. J.G. (17 year old female) was also located in the residence and appeared intoxicated. They immediately began CPR and continued for 20 minutes until the ER doctor declared death at 0121 hours. Ballot stated that while they were performing CPR, J.G. stated, "Brent lets us drink."

I contacted Hingbergen who stated that during CPR, she could smell the odor of alcohol coming from L.C. during compressions.


At approximately 1340 hours, I contacted J.G. who stated L.C. came to her house saying she found a party. Norton arrived shortly after L.C. with a full bottle of Rich and Rare Whiskey (R&R) which he provided to J.G. and L.C.

At approximately 1431 hours, Trooper Garcia and I contacted Norton at his residence. Post Miranda, Norton stated he had purchased a bottle of R&R in Selawik and contacted L.C. asking if she wanted to drink. He met L.C. at J.G.'s residence where he provided the alcohol to the two juvenile girls. Norton stated he had sex with L.C. by placing both his penis and his fingers inside her vagina. Norton stated that he knew L.C. was unconscious at the time of the act because he had to roll her onto her back, take her pants off, and she made no sounds throughout.

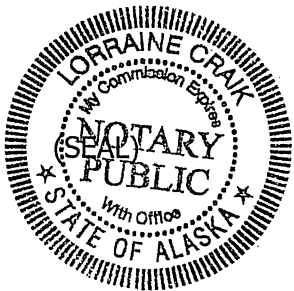
