Multnomah County, Oregon

Multnomah County has an unwritten policy which prohibits all communication with ICE. The county does not ask individuals it arrests about their immigration status and does not provide any information to ICE. The sheriff has communicated this policy directly to ERO, OPLA, and the local U.S. Attorney's Office. He also explained to the media, "[w]e're not going to cooperate or inform ICE about people's immigration status." See http://katu.com/news/local/sheriff-reese-says-immigration-polices-wont-change-despite-election. This statement highlights the sheriff's policy prohibiting or restricting the sharing of immigration status information with ICE, which appears to be in violation of section 1373.

I just called to receive two booking photos; was denied and spoke to the records manager (b)(6);(b)(7)(C) who directed me to this new policy which states they will not provide any information other than what is directly available to the public. We are also allegedly now "not allowed to enter their facilities except what is available to the public". The policy was updated on 5/1/2017, so this is the latest available. (b)(6):(b) claims that we were "never supposed to get them" after the original period of not receiving them (since approximately January, though we started getting them again in February).
