



DEMOLITION NOTES

1.

THE SUB-CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVAL OF DEMOLISHED MATERIALS FROM THE SITE. ALL MATERIALS SHALL BE DISPOSED OF IN A LAWFUL MANNER.
2.

FOR DEMOLITION WORK IN AREAS THAT ARE TO REMAIN PARTIALLY OCCUPIED, THE SUB-CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE DUST BARRIERS FOR PROTECTION AND WILL KEEP THE AREAS AS CLEAN AS POSSIBLE DURING WORK.
3.

DURING DEMOLITION, THE SUBCONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE CARE TO REMOVE AND PROTECT ALL REUSABLE MATERIALS SUCH AS DOORS, FRAMES, HARDWARE, LIGHT FIXTURES, AIR DEVICES, ETC. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE HOME OWNER ON PLACEMENT OF MATERIALS ON SITE.

THE SUBCONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR ALL HOLES IN EXTERIOR/INTERIOR WALLS, FLOORS, ETC. CAUSED BY CURRENT OR PREVIOUS DEMOLITION. PATCHES SHALL MATCH ADJACENT SURFACE.
