Chicago Architecture Foundation Center River Cruise aboard Chicago's First Lady Cruises Embarks on 25th Season Beginning March 31

Number one rated tour in Chicago announces 2018 schedule departing from the Chicago Riverwalk

CHICAGO, March 16, 2018 – In celebration of the 25th anniversary of their partnership connecting Chicago locals and visitors to the city's rich architectural history and now in 2018 to the new Chicago Architecture Center, [Chicago's First Lady Cruises](#) and [Chicago Architecture Center](#) (CAC) have announced the 2018 season schedule for the award-winning official [Chicago Architecture Foundation Center River Cruise aboard Chicago's First Lady Cruises](#), kicking off on Saturday, March 31.

Ranked as the #1 tour in Chicago based on [TripAdvisor user reviews](#), the CAFC River Cruise offer guests breathtaking panoramic views of Chicago's riverfront architecture with unmatched cruise commentary. The official cruise is the most in-depth architecture river cruise available and is the only one led by CAF-certified volunteer docents, who share their passion and knowledge of more than 50 significant buildings along the cruise route.

The 90-minute tour is lauded as best way to see world-famous architecture in Chicago, the birthplace of the skyscraper, with views that simply cannot be seen by foot. In 2017, [U.S. News & World Report](#) named the CAFC River Cruise one of the top six tours in Chicago for first-time visitors.

In addition to celebrating 25 years as partners, Chicago's First Lady Cruises and CAC celebrate the opening of the [Chicago Architecture Center](#), CAC's new world-class gateway connecting visitors and locals with all things Chicago architecture opening this summer. Conveniently located at 111 East Wacker Drive, above Chicago's First Lady Cruises' dock, the Center's tours, programs and a new set of interactive, digital exhibits will help cruise guests discover more secrets behind Chicago's architectural wonders.

Additional CAFC River Cruise offerings include the Capture Chicago Photography Cruise on summer Saturdays and Sundays, which is designed with photographers in mind by pausing three times throughout the cruise to get the best shots of the architectural marvels. The Twilight River Cruise, which runs summer Sundays through Fridays, occurs at sunset and gives guests stunning views of the city in a serene atmosphere.

All cruises depart from the southeast corner of Michigan Avenue and Wacker Drive and travel along all three branches of the Chicago River, offering unparalleled, social media-ready photo opportunities. Guests enjoy the

experience with open-air seating aboard luxurious vessels complete with a state-of-the-art sound system, a temperature controlled interior salon deck, full service bar, and marble and granite restrooms. Chicago's First Lady Cruises' fleet of six passenger yachts are also available for private weddings, corporate events and other special occasions.

CAFC River Cruise times vary throughout the season:

- The opening schedule runs March 31 – April 12 and offers cruises from Monday – Sunday at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 2 p.m. and 4 p.m.
- Early spring cruises run daily from April 13 - May 3 and depart at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 1 p.m., 2 p.m., 3 p.m. and 4 p.m. Additional cruises depart at 11 a.m. on Thursday – Sunday and 5 p.m. on Friday – Sunday.
- Late spring cruises operate daily from May 4 - May 17 and depart every hour from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Additional cruises depart on Thursday at 5 p.m. and Friday – Sunday at 9:30 a.m. 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., 3:30 p.m. and 5 p.m.
- Summer cruises sail daily May 18 - Oct. 8 and depart Monday – Thursday at 10 a.m., 11 a.m., 12 p.m., 1 p.m., 1:30 p.m., 2 p.m., 3 p.m., 3:30 p.m., 4 p.m., 5:30 p.m., 7:30 p.m. and every half hour from 9:30 a.m. – 4 p.m., 5 and 5:30 p.m. Friday - Sunday. Additional cruises depart at 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, 9 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday, and 7:30 p.m. on Friday and Sunday.
 - The Capture Chicago Photography Cruises depart Saturday and Sundays only at 9:00 a.m.
 - Twilight River Cruises depart at 7:30 p.m. Sunday – Friday only.
- Early fall cruises depart daily Oct. 9 - Oct. 28, departing at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 1 p.m., 2 p.m. and 3 p.m. with additional cruises Friday – Sunday at 11 a.m., 11:30 a.m., 1:30 p.m., 3:30 p.m., 4 p.m., 5 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
- Late fall cruises operate daily from Oct. 29 – Nov 19 with cruises departing daily at 10 a.m., 12 p.m., 2 p.m. and 4 p.m., with additional cruises departing at 11 a.m., 1 p.m., 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Friday – Sunday.

Boarding Location and Details

The CAFC River Cruise aboard Chicago's First Lady Cruises departs from the southeast corner of the Michigan Avenue Bridge at Wacker Drive just three blocks north of Millennium Park. A blue awning marks the entrance to the stairway leading to the Riverside Gardens docking area. Discounted self-park is located at 233 N. Michigan Avenue. Guests with limited mobility may find an ADA ramp located at State Street and Wacker Drive, and limited mobility drop-off directions can be found at CruiseChicago.com.

Ticket Information

Tickets are \$44.48 plus applicable taxes for the daytime river cruise and Capture Chicago Photography Cruise, and \$49.21 plus applicable taxes for the Twilight River Cruise. A portion of each ticket sale supports CAF's educational mission.
