THE INFLUENCE OF AI-ASSISTED VIRTUAL ROADTRIPS ON FACETS OF STUDENTS' CAREER **IDENTITY**

The Virtual Roadtrip is an Al-powered experience that takes learners on a "road trip" journey to help them navigate their future careers and educational pathways. Incorporating RTN's 13,600-video library of real-world interviews, the Virtual Roadtrip humanizes careers by showing learners deeply personal insights from people like them.

To gauge learner impact, we launched a pilot of the Virtual Roadtrip with 2,900 students across middle school, high school, community college, and university settings. Researchers from UC Irvine's Daplab analyzed 488 pre/post survey datasets.
