



RESOLUTION FROM THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST CONFERENCE to the Free Methodist Church in Canada RE: CANADA PACIFIC CONFERENCE

Whereas

the Pacific Northwest Conference has an established goal of mothering a conference

and whereas

the British Columbia districts have a vision to extend the kingdom in British Columbia and beyond

and whereas

the British Columbia districts have chosen to become the Canada Pacific Conference and to merge with the Free Methodist Church in Canada at the 2nd General Conference this July 30 - August 3, 1993,

therefore, be it resolved

that the Pacific Northwest Conference ratify the action of the Canada Pacific Conference on this 26th day of June, 1993

and be it further resolved

that the Pacific Northwest Conference commend the Canada Pacific Conference to the Free Methodist Church in Canada with sincere appreciation for their contribution to the life and vitality of the Pacific Northwest Conference.

Personnel Resources:

- 1. The issues of oversight and supervision have more to do with the establishment of new relationships than it does with distance. The telephone will continue to be the link between us.
- 2. The Canadian Executives, (Bishop, Executive Director) have assured us of three trips a year per person which will provide the necessary oversight.
- 3. Manning the work will be carried out by the Ministerial Appointments Committee 1 elder, 2 lay persons, the Bishop, and the Superintendent

Finances

- 10% of local budget giving, (excluding world mission and designated gifts), be used for conference and denominational ministries. Local church treasurer to send 6% to conference treasurer and 4% to Canadian Ministries Centre for Canadian Global Ministries. (outreach - education - Canadian ministries).
- Missions to be raised independently as inspirational giving. Goal to be established by CPD BOA (5% of money raised to be kept in Conference for publicity.)
- 3. Formula to be reviewed within 3 years based on CP Conference performance and CGM needs.
- 4. That for the balance of 1993 (Aug-Dec) funds designated for UMC World Missions be forwarded in the usual manner to Indianapolis.
- 5. That for the balance of 1993 (Aug-Dec) funds designated for UMC Home Ministries be retained in Canada by the FMCC for CGM Canadian, Outreach and Education Ministries.

RECOMMENDATION from the Canada Pacific Districts Board of Administration, January 16, 1993:

That the above Canada Pacific Conference Proposal on merging with the Free Methodist Church in Canada effective at the Second General Conference, July 30-August 3, 1993, be accepted and recommended to the Annual Meeting of the Canada Pacific Districts which will be held on May 28-29, 1993.
