

How do I get around Santiago?

The most convenient way to move around Santiago is through public transportation (https://www.red.cl/), or using applications such as Uber, Cabify or DiDi, or a private car.

The event's venue is located steps away from the La Moneda Metro station (line 1), which you can reach through the same Metro line, or by combining this service with the RED buses. To plan your trip, you can use the RED application or do it directly on the website https://www.red.cl/planificatu-viaje/

To get to and from the Arturo Merino Benítez International Airport, we recommend the following options:

- Hire cars or group or shared transfers, through their websites, such as <u>TransVip</u> or <u>Radiotaxi Solución</u>, or at their official premises located on the first floor of the airport. It is important that, when hiring a transportation service, you only use the authorized services available on site.
- You can also consider using the Cabify transportation app.
- Take bus number 555, which is part of the RED integrated public transportation system. To pay for the ticket you must purchase a Bip! Card or install the RED mobile app, which comes with an integrated Bip!QR paying system, which facilitates access and payment process for passengers. - Take the Centropuerto bus, available on the 3rd lane of the first level, between exits 4 and 5. The one-way ticket costs CLP\$2,000 and the round trip costs CLP\$3,000. The journey is approximately 40 minutes. The bus takes you to Metro line 1 (Los Héroes or Pajaritos). https://www.centropuerto.cl/faq

Where can I exchange Chilean pesos?

We recommend that you exchange your currency into Chilean pesos only in official exchange offices, which are either located at the airport or throughout the city in established locations. In particular, Agustinas Street in Santiago Centro has multiple exchange offices.

In any case, almost all commercial establishments throughout Santiago accept payment by credit and debit card.
