APPLICATION PROCEDURES

MA Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Students entering the Women's Studies Master's Program in the fall semester will enter the two year cohort. Students entering in the spring semester will take electives in their area of concentration and begin the cohort the following fall.

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- 1. APPLICATION**
Send this completed application, along with items #2, #3 & #4 below, to the Graduate Director of Women's Studies via postal mail only. Email or faxed attachments will not be accepted.
 - 2. TRANSCRIPTS**
Main one official transcript from each educational institution you have attended to the address below.
 - 3. ESSAY**
Compose a 500 word essay in which you explain why you are interested in pursuing a Master of Arts Degree in Women's Studies. Please be sure to discuss how completion of the MA degree will play a role in your future goals – whether they be academic, professional and/or personal.
 - 4. ONE WRITING SAMPLE**
Sample may be a newspaper article, web-based essay, professional material, or academic paper.
 - 5. RECOMMENDATIONS**
Have two different individuals who are familiar with your work send confidential Letters of Recommendation directly to the Women's Studies Graduate Director at the address below. Do NOT send these letters yourself.
 - 6. APPLY TO THE SCHOOL OF GRADUATE STUDIES**
In addition to this application for admission to the Women's Studies Master of Arts Degree Program, you must also complete an application for admission to the SCSU School of graduate Studies and have your original transcripts mailed directly to the office of Graduate Studies. If you have not received a copy of the application for admission to the School of Graduate Studies, contact the Graduate Office at (203) 392-7000 to have the application form sent to you.
