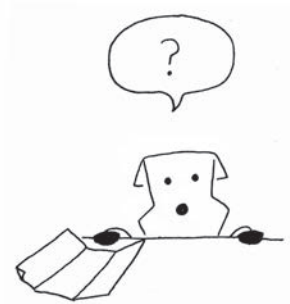
Ask our Visitor Services team any questions you might have about your visit, including parking, access services, public transportation, and local attractions.



**Enjoy art with eyes and ears, not hands or paws.**



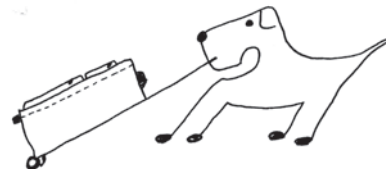
**Leave food and drinks outside.**

Photography for personal use is allowed—without flash, lights, or tripod. Art on loan to the Museum may not be photographed. Videotaping is not permitted in the galleries.

Sketching is welcome in the galleries with pencil only. Copyists wishing to work with other media should call 443-573-1730.

Lockers are provided free at the Checkroom for bags and items larger than 11" x 15" in any direction, including backpacks, packages, laptops, umbrellas, and diaper bags. Please check backpack baby carriers. Strollers are welcome.

Pets, bicycles, scooters, skateboards, glass containers, and alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the Sculpture Gardens.
