Guidelines: PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

- Entries MUST BE ORIGINAL.
- Artists must label their media and methods accurately.
- Submission photos should be high quality, accurate representations of the artwork.
- Artwork photos should NOT include frame.
- Juror and/or Exhibits Chair have final authority to define what constitutes an acceptable entry.

Eligible Media:

Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Pastel, Ink, Pencil, Mixed Media, Collage, Printmaking, Photography, Sculpture, Pottery, Mosaic, Fiber.

Framing & Hanging Requirements:

- All framed work MUST be secure using appropriate materials.
- Stretched canvases must be framed if depth is less than one inch.
- Mats must be white or off-white.
- All work must have securely fastened hanging wire utilizing "D" rings - no saw tooth hangers or eye rings.
- Hanging wires must have ends covered or taped.
- Works on paper must be securely matted or floated under glass, Plexiglas, or plastic boxes.
- Art Call Submission label must be attached to the top, backside of the artwork.
- If an accepted work comes apart due to poor framing it may be removed from the exhibit.

Size and Weight Limits:

- 2-D: maximum framed work, 50 inches on any one side including frame and 25 pounds.
- 3-D: maximum, 48 inches high with or without stand, maximum 50 pounds; 'foot-print' of 2 feet square. The floor may be used for display to minimize lifting by volunteers.
- Online submission dimensions are of the image only, without mat or frame.

Not Eligible:

- Entries accepted in previous AAC shows
- Artwork produced in WORKSHOPS or CLASSES
- Gicleés of original works
- Installations and/or videos
- Wet or unfinished pieces
- Renderings based on the work of others or copyright protected
- Work more than 5 years old

Art Sales and Use of Images:

- Art displayed as part of any AAC Exhibit fall under the purview of AAC for the full duration of the exhibit. All purchases of art shall include sales tax and shall be payable in full to AAC.
- AAC shall receive 30% commission from the artist within 30 days of purchase. Commission paid by artists is determined by AAC Board of Directors per organization bylaws.
- Private sales between an AAC exhibiting artist and buyer is strictly prohibited.
- By submitting work to an AAC exhibit you are agreeing to allow images of your work to be used for promotional material. Every effort will be made to credit artists for their work.

Erin earned a BFA in Jewelry/Metalwork & Art History from the University of Georgia. Erin continued her studies at the Atlanta Art Therapy Institute and the University of Massachusetts. In 2017 Erin was an Artist in Residence at Wild Acres in North Carolina and the following year at the Bridge & Falls program in Ontario, Canada. Erin has worked for the City of Atlanta, Office of Cultural Affairs and as the gallery director at ART Station. Her award-winning paintings have been exhibited throughout the southeast and in 2018 she held her first solo exhibit at the Snellville City Gallery. Erin's work is in both private and public collections, including a purchase award from Fulton County for their permanent public art collection.
