

Care at New Life

Care happens in a variety of ways here at New Life. Some of the best ways it occurs is when you are connected in a Life Group, Serving Team or in a Ministering Elders Group.

Life Groups happen throughout the community and are a way for people to deepen their faith, develop friendships and serve together (Learn, Love & Live). Serving Teams also create some of the same dynamics. When a need for care arises people share their concern with the leader of their group. If you are newer to New Life you can fill out a Get Connected Card, or check out the website for more information.

Ministering Elders Groups are about 8-12 families that have a Ministering Elder who connects and helps them with their questions. The Elder will also arrange for help in times of need, which would include visitation at home or hospital.

The Community of Care is our weekly Prayer, Praise and Celebration publication. It is available to read and/or print from the church website www.nl-cc.org. Just click on "Community of Care" under the Resources tab. You can also ask to have it come to your inbox every week. On the Get Connected Card, just indicate that you would like to have it emailed to you and include your email address.

You may also pick up a printed copy on Sunday mornings in the lobby, or at the Info Center. To submit a prayer request, simply use the Get Connected card, mark it "OK to publish" or email the church office at info@nl-cc.org.

Letting your Life Group Facilitator, Serving Team Leader, Ministering Elder and/or staff member know of the need is usually the quickest way to have someone pray with you and to receive and give care to one another.
