## Surface:

- Stones that are oddly shaped work really great for this project (the more cracked the better)

## Paint Palette:

- DecoArt Americana Décor Chalky Finish Paint
  - Carbon – ADC29
  - Keepsake – ADC34
  - Rejuvenate – ADC32
  - Promise – ADC22
  - Innocence – ADC05
  - Romance – ADC06
  - Escape – ADC20
  - Keepsake – ADC34

## Prep, Mediums and Finish

- DecoArt DuraClear Polyurethane Varnish: Ultra Matte - DS124

## Brushes

- Royal Aqualon
  - #10 Shader - R2150
  - 20/0, #2 & 5 Round - R2250

Tip: If you have great hand control, the Royal Aqualon #4 script liner (#2585) will create the most amazing cracks on the stones. Just make sure your paint is fluid enough.

## General Supplies:

- Royal Brush Square Brush Basin – RD325
- Unstick Reusable Arts and Crafts Sheet
- Rubbing Alcohol
- Stylus or Toothpick
- Dish Soap and Scrubby Pad/Brush
- Mister Bottle Filled with Water
- Paper Towels
- Baby, Kitchen Wipes or Kitchen cloths (for dry rub application)
- Heat Gun
- DecoArt Media Brush and Stencil Cleaner - DMM13
