Brushes

- Royal Aqualon
 - o #10 Shader R2150
 - o 20/0, #2 & 5 Round R2250

Tip: If you have great hand control, the Royal Aqualon #4 script liner (#2585) will create the most amazing cracks on the stones. Just make sure your paint is fluid enough.
