Feb 28, 1957

The sesai waloni early this a.m. & the children were up & ready for them, with torches & lanterns, leaving about 4:40 a.m.

Overcast a.m. (no rain last nite); sun beg. to come out at 7:15.

The grass is githy green. During Feb 18-25, when I was down, there were 2 hard rains ^{7:30}, & the grass was green-brown. Feb. 26, ^{start} P.M., there was a hard rain, lasts 1/45 mins; the grass is now rather green. Sun came out fully at 9: a.m. Hot day. Clouds & lite wind & brief sporadic rain at 6 pm for 15 mins. Overcast thereafter & cooler. Lite rain & brief, beg. 9:30.

Cool & overcast till 9 or so. Sun. rather hot.
Pleasant evening; stars.

March 1, 1958

March 2, 1957

Sun at 6:15 or a bit before. nice. grass almost
completely green. Many sesai wings about. Sunny
except for a few clouds now & then. Pineapples,
the big ones, are available.

March 2, 1958

March 3, 1957

A bright early a.m., with the sun almost
out. Clear sun at 9 or so. All sunny. Warm
at nite.

March 3, 1958

March 4, 1957

Clear sun before 6:15; went cloudy at 7; much sun
beg. 8 or so; hot; very late 3 min. sprinkle at 1:10 PM; hot &
damp. We fish were "in" today. The people lined up at
11:40 a.m. + made the big reel at 11:50.

Heavy 30 min. wind beg. at 5; sporadic, but not
hard, gusts of rain until 7:00 ad. Cool evening.

Little sun today; no rain; stars; not cool.

overcast; little rain from 7:12 - 7:20; sun at 8:10;
mostly cloudy til noon; 2-min. sunshine shows about
pm; 1 distant thunder at 6:30; few stars.

May 26, 1957

Brief & little rain about 5 a.m. (I am told); sun at
7:45 a.m.; mostly cloudy, however, til noon; mostly
sunny in aft; warm.

May 27, 1957

Sun about 8:30; mostly cloudy day; warm; a little
so brief rain scattered during the note. Plenty of
crayes now & they are rather sweet.

May 28, 1957

A beautiful early a.m.; some clouds
~~that~~ off & on during the day; a very brief &
little drizzle about 9 a.m.; a few drops of
rain at 9:30 p.m.

May 29, 1957

A few drops of rain about 4 a.m.; bright a.m.
but no sun til 8 or so; 2 min. little sun-shine
shows about 10 a.m.; mostly sunny in aft; no
stars at 7 p.m.; warm. Horseflies going; crayes
plentiful.

rain (all this at 8:45 pm); stars;
partly overcast.

rain beg. in the nite & raining steadily but
lightly most of the nite (^{the} 2 drums at student home
were filled).

The previous ^{dry} season
