

Important information for California/New York NAACLS Accredited Students

California Licensure AND ASCP Certification

The ASCP Board of Certification examinations have been approved for licensure purposes by the state of California. It is important students complete the <u>Online Application for ASCP certification</u>.

Students must meet the eligibility requirements established by the ASCP Board of Certification (BOC) **and** the licensure requirements established by the state of California. The student must also successfully complete the appropriate ASCP BOC certification examination.

STEP 1: The student must contact the **CDPH Laboratory Field Service web site** for information on completing the licensure process and submit an application to California.

STEP 2: The student should review the **eligibility requirements** for the appropriate examination category (MLS, MLT, PBT, MB, CG) to be sure the student has met these requirements.

STEP 3: The student must complete the <u>Online Application for ASCP certification</u>. An official transcript verifying the degree must be submitted to the ASCP Board of Certification. Detailed eligibility requirements are located at: <u>www.ascp.org/certification</u>

STEP 4: After successful completion of the examination and notice of certification, the student must place an online order through the ASCP website for <u>verification of their certification</u> to be submitted to the California LFS office.

New York Licensure AND ASCP Certification

The ASCP Board of Certification examinations have been approved for licensure purposes by the state of New York. It is important students complete the <u>Online Application for ASCP certification</u>.

Students must meet the eligibility requirements established by the ASCP Board of Certification (BOC) **and** the licensure requirements established by the state of New York. The student must also successfully complete the appropriate ASCP BOC certification examination.

STEP 1: The student must contact the state of <u>New York website</u> for information on completing the licensure process and submit an application to New York.

STEP 2: The student should review the **eligibility requirements** for the appropriate examination category (MLS, MLT, CT, HT, PA) to be sure the student has met these requirements.

STEP 3: The student must complete the <u>Online Application for ASCP certification</u>. An official transcript verifying the degree must be submitted to the ASCP Board of Certification. Detailed eligibility requirements are located at: <u>www.ascp.org/certification</u>

STEP 4: After successful completion of the examination and notice of certification, the student must place an online order through the ASCP website for verification of their certification to be submitted to the New York State Education Department.
