Henriette Langdon, EdD, CCC-SLP, has 40 years of experience working with bilingual children who have a variety of speech, language, and learning challenges. For almost half her career, she has been a professor at San José State University, where she has taught classes on bilingualism, language disorders, assessment, and literacy. In collaboration with Terry Saenz, she completed a resource entitled “Working with interpreters and translators: A guide for speech-language pathologists and audiologists,” which was published in October 2015 (Plural Publishing). Two additional books she wrote on the topic (one with Lilly Cheng) are in their second edition. Langdon is fluent in Spanish, French, and Polish, and she taught Spanish and French to her daughter.
