

# 4-H Teen Leader Job Description

## Poultry, Rabbit, & Cavy

### Prior to Fair

- Make a schedule for pullorum testing for poultry on Sunday
- Create herdsmanship poster for tent

### Wednesday

- Assist with 4-H setup

### Friday and/or Saturday

- Assist with Poultry/Rabbit cage setup as scheduled by open class superintendent and fair

### Sunday

- Assist with arriving animals, verify animal ID, and assign coops. Make master list of exhibits by coop number.
- Conduct Tent meeting for exhibitors.
  - Inform 4-Hers about herdsmanship
  - Go over barn rules
- Collect permission slips from exhibitors.
- Assist State Vets as needed.

### During Fair

#### Daily

- Coordinate Herdsmanship Judging twice daily
- See that all animals have adequate access to food and water. Report neglected exhibits to the 4-H superintendent.

#### Prior to Show Day

- Organize ribbons and trophies for shows.

#### Show Day

- Assist with setup prior to the show.
- Pick up judge's food money, ribbons, trophies and show books from the 4-H office.
- Greet judge and attend to all needs including lunch if necessary.
- Be sure that the official show book will be filled out, and return it to the 4-H office after the show.
- Assist with show.
- Return unused ribbons etc. to 4-H office.

#### Saturday

- Assist with Super Showmanship Competition
- Total herdsmanship scores in the morning
- Announce scores, winners and distribute awards at the ceremony under the show tent
- Check out exhibit animals as scheduled by Open Class Superintendent
