

## 4-H Teen Leader Job Description Horse

### Prior to Fair

#### Wednesday

- Assist with 4-H setup

#### Friday and/or Saturday

- Prepare Barn area. Put up signs

### During Fair

#### Monday/Tuesday

- Check in arriving animals and assign stalls.
- Conduct Barn meeting for exhibitors.
- Assist State Vets as needed.

#### Daily

- Check in arriving animals and assign stalls.
- Conduct Barn meeting for exhibitors.
  - Inform 4-Her's about herdsmanship
  - Go over barn rules
- Assist State Vets as needed.
- Coordinate Herdsmanship Judging twice daily
- See that all animals have adequate access to food and water. Report neglected exhibits to the 4-H superintendent.

### Prior to Each Show Day

- Organize ribbons and trophies for shows.

### Show Days

- Assist with show setup prior to the show.
- Pick up judge's checks and thank you note, ribbons and trophies from the 4-H office.
- Greet judge and attend to all needs. Assist with show.
- Return unused ribbons etc. to 4-H office.

### Saturday/Friday

- Total herdsmanship scores in the morning
- Announce scores, winners and distribute awards at the ceremony under the show tent
- Check out exhibit animals as scheduled by Open Class Superintendent
