Prior to Fair

Wednesday

- Assist with 4-H building exhibit area setup.

Thursday

- As assigned, assist with judging in your area. See that judges have all needed supplies, judging sheets, and a box for collecting entry cards.
- Mark entry cards as per judges' instructions, separate and collect bottom half, and attach ribbon to top half. Mark voucher.
- Set aside items to be re-judged for State Fair.

During Fair

Monday

- As assigned, assist with judging in your area. See that judges have all needed supplies, judging sheets, and a box for collecting entry cards.
- Mark entry cards as per judges' instructions, separate and collect bottom half, and attach ribbon to top half. Mark voucher.
- Set aside items to be re-judged for State Fair.
- Attend Tour Training

Daily

- As assigned, setup, coordinate, conduct and clean-up special area activities. Including:
 - 4-H Children's Center
 - Photographing 4-H Shows and Events
 - Mannequin Modeling
 - 4-H Clothing Revue
 - 4-H Presentations
 - Milk & Cookies Contest
- Help maintain a clean and attractive display for viewing by the public. This includes emptying trashcans, watering flowers and sweeping the building daily.

After Fair

Saturday Evening and/or Sunday

- As assigned, help tear down the 4-H building display area, pack supplies, and store everything for use next year.
