NYSDEC Endorsed 4 Hour Erosion & Sediment Control <u>Required</u> Training Tuesday, October 25, 2016

Registration begins at 8:00am; Workshop begins <u>promptly</u> at 8:30am Photo ID required on the day of training.

Under the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation's General Permit GP-0-15-002, all developers, contractors and subcontractors must identify at least one *trained contractor* from their company that will be responsible for implementation of the SWPPP, and have at least one *trained contractor* on site on a daily basis when soil disturbance activities are being performed. Also, developers must have a *qualified inspector* conduct regular site inspections in accordance with GP-0-15-002.

*Qualified inspectors and trained contractors must attend 4 hours of training in the principles and practices of erosion and sediment control endorsed by NYS DEC every 3 years.

Upon completion, each participant will receive a NYSDEC SWT-number valid for 3 years.

Training is required for those who are **not** CPESC, LA, or PE certified.
