### **Equine Project Medal Criteria**

*The following criteria must be met in order to be eligible for a Project Medal in the Horse area.  
**Bring this completed form with you to your interview.** Be sure you have checked (✓) and filled in all sections below.*

- Must bring to the interview: (1) this completed criteria form with listings to back up the requirements below; (2) photos or supportive props or documents about your 4-H and Equine activities.
- Must be a currently enrolled 4-H member and enrolled in the Equine Project area for at least 1 year. Cloverbud years do not count toward the 1 year minimum.
- Must participate in Project Interview at which time 4-H member presents and discusses their year in 4-H.
- Must come to the interview prepared to talk about their goals for the past year, if they achieved those goals, new things they learned or tried and any special highlights of their 4-H year.
- Must come to the interview prepared to talk about their project animal. Youth should have appropriate knowledge on the animal's care & management, health records, training/show preparation, and nutrition/diet requirements.
- Must have completed an approved Creative Communication event or activity in the project area in the current 4-H year.
