

CLEANING LEAD DUST OUT OF WINDOWS

IT ONLY TAKES A TINY AMOUNT OF LEAD
DUST TO POISON A CHILD

Directions:

- All cleaning of windows needs to be done with PAPER TOWELS **NOT** cloths or rags.
- Change paper towels often and **NEVER** place used towels on the floor or furniture.
- Have a garbage bag handy and put each used paper towel into it the bag once the paper towel is dirty.

Step 1: Put cleaner in spray bottle.

Step 2: Beginning at the top of the window, working down. Spray and wipe the window and frame areas.

Step 3: Spray window well until wet and wipe out paint chips and dust. Continue until no more paint chips or dust can be seen.

Step 4: Spray and wipe the window sill. Continue to wipe until no paint chips or dust can be seen.

REMINDER:

ALWAYS – keep children away from the area that is being cleaned.

ALWAYS – wash your hands after cleaning areas that might have lead dust.

WARNING:

Unborn and nursing babies can become lead poisoned when mothers are exposed to lead. Pregnant women and nursing mothers should have someone else clean window areas.
