Remember: Lead Poisoning Prevention is Doable. Lead Poisoning is Irreversible!



“This amount of household dust contaminated with lead-based paint can cause irreversible childhood lead poisoning.”

Lead Poisoning... Doesn't Discriminate.

It can affect anyone, regardless of race, age, income, gender, schooling, or address.

Lead Poisoning... Lasts a Lifetime.

Once a child's body and brain have been affected by lead poisoning, the damage is *irreversible*.

Lead Poisoning... Costs More Than Money.

It costs communities manpower, time, and countless resources, and it costs our children their *futures*.

Lead Poisoning... Is Everybody's Issue.

From parents to teachers, doctors to police, construction workers to elected officials...lead poisoning is everybody's issue.

CLPPPP UTICA HOUSING SERVICES

CLPPPP stands for “Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program.” Oneida County receives special funding to help Utica property owners and residents identify and correct housing conditions that lead to childhood lead poisoning. To see if you live, own, or rent property in a City neighborhood that is eligible for services call us: **315-736-3394, x251.**

- ◆ **WHO:** CLPPPP property owner services are available to inner city Utica property owners and landlords, regardless of income.
- ◆ **WHAT:** Participants may be eligible for housing inspections and lead-safe clearances, free paint and primer, free repair supplies, work plan guidance, referrals for other housing services, and tuition to an EPA Certified Renovator course — required by law since 2010 for those who lease and/or remodel rental properties.
- ◆ **WHERE:** Properties must be within CLPPPP's Central Utica Service Area. Call to see if you qualify.
- ◆ **WHEN:** Free services and appointments are available year-round, and are scheduled at your convenience.
- ◆ **WHY:** It's simple! CLPPPP is called Oneida County's “Primary” lead poisoning prevention program because our children's **FIRST** line of defense should be their **HOME!**

And did we say FREE? Everything is FREE!

SOME FACTS ABOUT LEAD POISONING

Lead poisoning has irreversible effects on our minds and bodies, but is especially harmful to pregnant women, nursing moms, and children through the age of six. The most common source of lead poisoning is pre-1978 paint, or dust from painted surfaces released through friction and deterioration. And, there are other sources of lead that most of us aren't even aware of — for instance, imported toys, spices, batteries, lead pipes, cosmetics, ceramic glazes, ammunition, fishing gear, crayons, chalk, talcum powder, vinyl blinds and hoses, to name a few!
