AWARDS

Bronze Award – Completion of Community Service events in at least three (3) categories.

Silver Award – Completion of Community Service events in at least four (4) categories.

Gold Award – Completion of Community Service events in at least five (5) categories.

Example: Doing events in Environmental Service, Intergenerational Service and Community/Government Service would qualify a club for a Bronze Award.

Emerald Award – one winner only

Awarded to the club with the most extensive record of community service for the year. Winner must complete at least one event in all five categories and at least three events in two categories to qualify for consideration.

Prizes – All prizes will be food certificates such as pizza, etc.
