In case of snow/severe weather

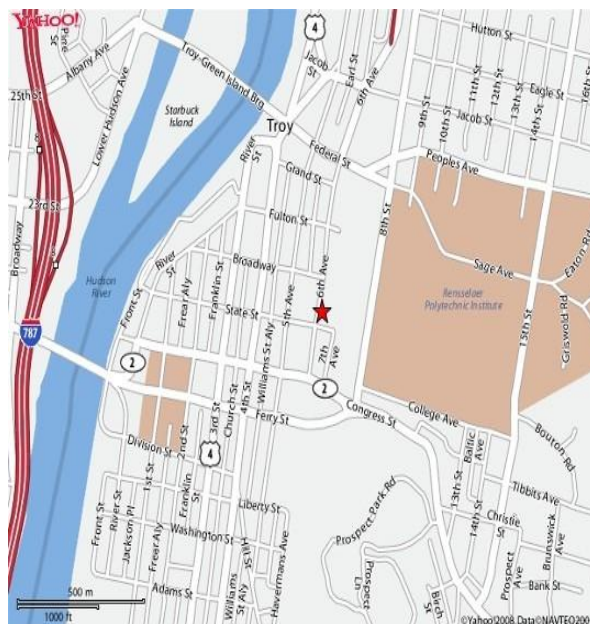
conditions: Every effort will be made to notify class participants of class cancellations. February 9 and 16 may be used as "make-up" class days if a previous class must be cancelled.

Directions to Cornell Cooperative Extension of Rensselaer County:

From Albany: (exit 23 off NYS Thruway) Travel north on Rt. 787 to exit 8. Take a right at the end of the ramp and another right at the next light. Cross the Green Island bridge and take a right at the second light onto 6th Ave. At the second light take a left onto State St. and we are located on the 2nd floor of the Brick building on the top of the hill to the left.

From Route 87 (Northway): (exit 24 off NYS Thruway) Take Exit 7 to route 7 east. As you cross the Collar City Bridge (Hudson River) take the "Downtown Troy" exit, stay in the left lane of the exit ramp to 6th Ave. At the fourth traffic light (State St.) take a left and park in the parking lot at the end of the street. We are located on the second floor of the brick building labeled "Health Department" (it was built as the Health Department in 1920).

Purpose: This course is offered as *part* of the training requirements needed for people seeking to become certified as pesticide technicians in category 3a (turf and ornamentals) OR certified as a private applicator in category 25 (nursery, ornamentals and turf) by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC). As such, 30 hours of training must be presented to class attendees. For *complete* requirements, contact the NYSDEC at (518) 357-2234 or visit the website <http://www.dec.ny.gov/permits/45618.html>

When you successfully attend this entire class, you should be eligible to take the NYSDEC exams.

Course Content: Topics covered in this training include: Becoming a Certified Pesticide Applicator; History of Pesticide Use; Introduction to Pests; Pesticide Labels; IPM; Pesticide Application and Equipment; Mixing and Filling; the Worker Protection Standard; Calibration; Pesticide Storage and Disposal; Toxicity of Pesticides; Pesticide Safety; Pesticide Information Resources; Category Specific Topics

Over 90% of participants have successfully passed their exams. Compare this rate to other training courses!

Class location: All classes will be held at the Cornell Cooperative Extension of Rensselaer County, 61 State Street, Troy, NY.

Class Time: Class will be held from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM each day. An hour will be allowed for lunch. Lunch is not provided, so bring your own or plan to visit a local eatery (only limited options are available close by).

Class Materials: Class attendees are encouraged to bring a pen or pencil, notebook, and calculator to each class.

Registration fee includes the 3rd Edition Core and Category 3a OR Category 25 pesticide training manuals.

Please note that you will also need to pay a fee to the NYSDEC to take the exams which is NOT covered in the registration fee for this course.

The pesticide exams will be given at the offices of NYSDEC in Schenectady (dates TBA)

Class space is limited. Register early to avoid disappointment. Deadline is January 26, 2018 OR WHEN CLASS IS FILLED.

• **Note:** This course might be co-listed as a Private Category 25 training class by the NYSDEC. Attendees are welcome to register as a Category 25 participant, but should be aware that the instruction will focus on Category 3a content and materials.
