Sharps

Safely store and transport needles, syringes, lancets and other sharp medical items.

Sharps should be stored in a puncture resistant container, which can be purchased at a pharmacy. A thick plastic container, such as an old laundry detergent bottle, may be used but must be properly labeled HAZARDOUS: SHARPS. Always store sharps safely out-of-reach of children to minimize risk of injury.

When transporting a sharps container, tape the lid of the container closed and deliver to a staff member at a location listed in this brochure.

- DO NOT put sharps in unlabeled containers
- DO NOT put sharps in trash OR recycling
- DO NOT store sharps in glass containers
- DO NOT re-use or share medical needles

Medications

Prescription and over-the-counter medications require special disposal. Always properly store all medications out of reach of children to minimize abuse or risk of injury.

DO NOT dispose of medications in the trash
DO NOT dispose of medications down the sink,
toilet, etc.
