Spring Beach Walk

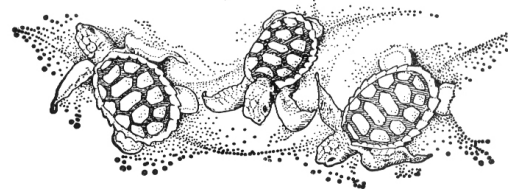
Mon, Apr 2, 2018 @ 9:30 - 11am (Ages 6-12)
