

What Is 4-H Kritter Kamp?

Kritter Kamp is a program for youth between the ages of 9 and 13 who have an interest in learning more about farm animals (dairy, goats, sheep and rabbits). Youth will spend two days (including overnight) at 4-H Acres learning about animal behavior and care, different breeds, anatomy, the importance of agriculture and farm animals in our society, and general safety with animals. They will be provided with an animal and the equipment needed for the care and preparation of the animal for show. The highlight will be a livestock show Saturday afternoon. Participants will demonstrate what they have learned as they present their animal in the show ring. The program fee of \$60 covers all costs including food, equipment, tools and supplies, and educational materials. Limited scholarships are available upon request.
