Title: Energy and Money Saving Program Associate Educator

Responsibilities: Educator will help residents and local organizations in Tompkins County learn about ways to save energy and money in the four areas of energy, transportation, food, and waste reduction, with a focus on clean energy programs, such as energy efficiency, renewable heating, and solar. The educator will work with community partners, including local non-profits and businesses, to reach diverse groups of residents, with a focus on those with limited incomes. The educator will, in conjunction with partners, use a variety of creative options to provide useful and relevant information to audiences, including doing outreach at community events; presenting before large groups in different settings; speaking with people one-on-one over the phone or in person; coordinating with local energy contractors in providing accurate information on the programs, etc. This position will also assist with training, engaging and coordinating the work of volunteers and interns.

Qualifications: Associate's degree with 2 years related experience or Bachelor's degree or equivalent education. Ability to implement, teach and evaluate informal educational programs preferred. Ability to adapt to changing needs and handle multiple projects simultaneously. Able to work effectively with people of varying backgrounds.

Hours/Benefits: Position is full-time and includes full benefit package including health and dental insurance, retirement, life insurance and more.
