DAIRY GOAT / COMPANION / FUN CLASSES (all goats)

Entries must be postmarked or submitted to the 4-H Office by June 1.

All entries must have legible tattoo. **NO HORNS ALLOWED.** No goats under 2 months of age permitted. Buck kids 2 to 6 months of age will be permitted; however, if they are deemed unmanageable they will be removed from the fairgrounds.

All goats must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) with animals individually identified with USDA approved individual scrapie program identification. The CVI must contain a written Veterinary Statement stating that the herd of origin was inspected after May 1 of the current year and no evidence of contagious, infectious, or communicable disease was found, and USDA identification. Rabies vaccination strongly recommended. Do not send original certificates with entry form. Originals must accompany the animal.

Registration papers must be in the exhibitor's (or a parent/guardian's) name. No transfers accepted. Duplicate stamped copy for does under six months accepted. Registration papers and non-ownership papers must be submitted with entry.

Please note: Although judging will be based on American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA) standards, this is NOT an ADGA show.

Judging will begin Wednesday, 10 am

Exhibitors may show multiple entries in one class unless otherwise stated. The additional entries must be shown by another 4-H exhibitor. **If an exhibitor chooses to participate in state fair only two entries per class will be allowed at that event.**

Exhibitors must neat and clean and wearing white shirts and white pants for showmanship classes (with the exception of classes 94 - 103), exhibitors not complying will not be permitted to show and will forfeit premiums. Exhibitors may chose to change into a fair or 4-H shirt for non-showmanship classes. Any does over 24 months must have freshened at least once to be shown.

SECTION A
DAIRY GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

Exhibitors must enter one class in Section A to be eligible to participate in classes in Sections C - Q.

1. Senior – Youth must be 14 years or older as of January 1 of the current year.
2. Junior – Youth must be 13 years old or younger as of January 1 of the current year.
3. Novice – First time exhibitor in a dairy goat show (as of beginning of year), 4-H or open, 8 years and up.

SECTION B CLOVERBUDS

Awards: Participation ribbon only.

Cloverbuds may bring only one animal to the fair. Please note, bringing only one animal to the fair includes all animal areas so a Cloverbud cannot bring a large animal and a small animal.

If an enrolled Cloverbud would like to bring their own animal to the fair, this entry must be submitted by June 1.

Cloverbud Showmanship will occur **during the Dairy Goat Show after Section A: Dairy Goat Showmanship.**

5. Cloverbud Showmanship – Youth must be an enrolled Cloverbud (5 – 7 years old).

**SECTION M
GOAT JUDGING**

Contestants will judge a group of four dairy goats and place them, giving reasons for the placings. Any 4-H youth (whether they show dairy goats, meat goats, companion goats, or no goats) are encouraged to participate.

91. Senior – Oral reasons given over microphone.
92. Intermediate – Oral reasons stated.
93. Novice – Reasons given on paper.

**SECTION N
COMPANION/WORKING GOAT**

Animals may not be cross entered in meat goat or dairy goat classes. Exhibitors should be neat and clean. For classes 94, 95, and 96, there is no cross entering of goats (youth may show different goat in each class, but individual goat cannot be shown in both classes). If there are less than three youth entered in this section, the classes will be run as an exhibition. Any goat 2 years and over that has never been in milk should be shown in this class.

Exhibitors must enter one showmanship class to be eligible for participation in classes 97 – 98.

94. Working goat showmanship, Senior exhibitors – 14 to 19 years old.
95. Working goat showmanship, Junior exhibitors – 8 to 13 years old.
96. Working goat showmanship, Novice exhibitors – First time exhibitor in a goat show (as of beginning of year), 4-H or open, 8 years and up.
97. Companion - Clothing should be appropriate for hiking.
98. Pack Goat – Class will be judged by Pack Goat Fitting and Showmanship Scorecard (available at the 4-H Office). Requires pack for exhibitor and pack for goat. Clothing should be appropriate for hiking. Class includes an obstacle course. (If less than three youth are entered in this class it will be run as an educational demonstration.)

**SECTION O
JUST FOR FUN FOR DAIRY, COMPANION, OR MEAT GOATS**

99. Goat Costume Class – Dress up your goat and yourself. Use your imagination. Show off your talent. **This class will follow class 98 at the Wednesday 8:00 am Dairy Goat Show.**
100. Fitting Competition – Form teams of 2-3 youth and compete in preparing a goat for showing. This is a timed event. Each team will have 30 minutes to prepare their animal. Event will be held on Monday at 12:00 pm (noon).
101. Goat Obstacle Course – Judged by how well the youth and goat work together to master the obstacle course.
