Entries must be postmarked or submitted to the 4-H Office by June 1.

Name of animal, date of birth, ear notches, ear tag and/or tattoo number must be submitted at time of entry. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT CLEAR IDENTIFICATION!

All exhibitors showing animals owned by others must submit non-ownership papers at time of entry.

Exhibitors may make no more than two (2) entries in a class unless otherwise stated. The second entry must be shown by another 4-H exhibitor.

All swine must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (with **animals individually identified**). Rabies vaccination strongly recommended. Do not send original certificates with entry form. Originals must accompany the animal.

Judging will begin 7:00 pm, Monday

SECTION A SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

Exhibitors must enter one class to be eligible for participation in show classes.

1. Senior – 14 to 19 years old.
2. Junior – 8 to 13 years old.
3. Novice – All first time exhibitors at Orleans County 4-H Fair must show in this class, 8 years and up.

SECTION B MARKET

5. Feeder Pig – 40 pounds to 85 pounds.
6. Market hog – Less than 220 pounds. Classes will be further grouped by weight
7. Market hog – 220 pounds or more. Classes will be further grouped by weight
8. Market Auction – Animals must be shown in appropriate market class. See RULES GOVERNING MARKET ANIMAL AUCTION (Fair Book pages 3-5) for complete details. No premium points will be awarded. Market auction will be held on Saturday at 7:00 pm.

SECTION C BREEDING

9. Breeding gilt – classes to be grouped by breed and age if applicable. Gilts entered in the market program are not eligible.
10. Young Boar – Born after January 1 of current year.

SECTION D

OTHER

11. Bred and Owned – Must be bred and owned by exhibitor.
12. Pen of Three – Shall consist of three barrows and/or gilts owned by one exhibitor. All animals must be shown in their individual classes to be eligible.

SECTION E SWINE HERDSMANSHIP

13. Herdsmanship – See herdsmanship description on Fair Book pages 34-35.

SECTION F CLOVERBUDS

Awards: Participation ribbon only.

Cloverbuds may bring only one animal to the fair. Please note, bringing only one animal to the fair includes all animal areas so a Cloverbud cannot bring a large animal and a small animal.

If an enrolled Cloverbud would like to bring their own animal to the fair, this entry must be submitted by June 1.

Cloverbud Showmanship will occur **during the Swine Show after Section A: Swine Showmanship.**

14. Cloverbud Showmanship – Youth must be an enrolled Cloverbud (5 – 7 years old).
