This trailer information will help us determine how to park trailers in a more uniform way and less congested. Trailers parked at the horse arena are supposed to stay all week, please tell us in advance about your trailering needs so we can make parking easier and more accessible.

Those who sign up for a stall will receive a letter whether or not a stall is available along with other important information. We will strive to send your letter by the end of June.

1. Horses brought to the fairgrounds for stabling must stay from Sunday to Sunday. They are considered an exhibit for people to see.
2. If you are showing only one day, you are encouraged to trailer in for that day. There are circumstances and reasons for staying all week, so don't get too discouraged. We try very hard to accommodate everyone's needs. This would only be a problem if we run out of stall availability.
3. Please bring only those horses you intend to show at the fair. Don't bring them for experience or just in case you need them. Backup horses are not eligible for stalls unless replacing horses originally entered.
4. We have 25 available stalls. Tack/wheel barrow stalls are only available if there are extra stalls. You cannot reserve a stall for storage purposes.
5. Too many times we see horses are not used. If you bring your horse, you need to participate as planned unless there is a dangerous situation or illness. Someone may have needed your stall.
6. No hay bags – bring water and grain bucket. Bedding will not be provided.
7. Horses and their stalls are to be taken care of throughout the day. Do water checks continually.
Horses fed and stalls cleaned by 9 am and 6 pm. Work should be done by the exhibitor.
8. Selecting stalls: Exhibitors shall get preference of stall based on their participation in Orleans County 4-H Horse Events, as tracked by the "Betty Vanderlaan Memorial Award" Application (see below). The Superintendent will make every effort to fulfil requests, but may have to negate requests to create a safe atmosphere.
9. Horse stall decorating contest with anonymous judges: Best overall stall and 3 categories to be picked by judges. Previous winning stall designs are not to be repeated.
Portable stalls: Use staples, no tape please. You may hang your displays from the stall front bars.
Barn stalls: Staples are fine.
No decorations displayed inside stalls. Please be prepared to take out all staples at the end of Fair Week.
10. **Very Important! Please plan on the Monday night after fair to come for clean-up.** Make it a club thing. This is also sign-up night for state fair qualifiers.
11. The Superintendent has the right to expel any horses and/or exhibitors from the barn for any reason seen unfit.
12. Have a blast at the fair and enjoy the barn, your horse, and your friends!
