Section A Food and Nutrition

1. Any project related to food and nutrition. See 4-H age projects in Department 13, Section DA for examples.

Section B Fine Arts and Crafts

2. Any project which is a fine art or craft. See 4-H age projects in Department 13, Section DB and DC for examples.

Section C Communications

3. Any written or visual communication project. See 4-H age projects in Department 13, Section C for examples.

Section D Clothing and Textiles

4. Any clothing or fabric project including wearables. See 4-H age projects in Department 13, Section DD and DE for examples.

Section E Photography

5. Any project related to photography. See 4-H age projects in Department 13, Section E for examples.

Section F Horticulture

6. Any project related to plants and plant science. See 4-H age projects in Department 13, Section F and H for examples.

Section G STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)

7. Any projects related to woodworking, electrical, rocketry, geospatial science or renewable resources including recycling. See 4-H age projects in Department 13, Sections JA through JF for examples.

Section I Clothing Review

8. Participants will be responsible for submitting commentary. Limit one outfit per youth.
