- Judges decision is FINAL!
- Current Negative Coggins (within 2 calendar years) and Rabies Certificate required.
- Proper attire required.
- Jr. and Youth Walk/Trot Riders must be a minimum of 6 years of age and are 18 years and under as of January 1st.
- Adult Walk/Trot classes are open to anyone 19 and over, however, the horse and rider combination may not enter any other division.
- Walk/Trot/Canter classes are for **Riders** who are in their 1st or 2nd year of cantering.
- ***Weather Permitting Trail classes to be held in a separate area from main ring and to be completed between the hours of 12 Noon and 2PM while the rest of the show is going on.
- Command classes are in the Western Pleasure Division and require pleasure type tack.

ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR AN ASTM/SEI APPROVED PROTECTIVE HELMET AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED ON A HORSE ON THE 4-H GROUNDS AND IN <u>ALL</u> CLASSES IN THE RING. HELMETS MAY BE INSPECTED AT ANY TIME.
