Details:

- **Eligible to participate:** 4-H youth ages 8 to 18 enrolled in Orleans or another county. *
- **Registration Fee:** \$35/youth registrations received on or before May 1, 2018.
- **Orleans County 4-H** youth may use two incentive points to reduce the cost of registration to \$25.
- **Paperwork:** A copy of the rabies certificate must be submitted with the registration form. All dogs that are brought to dog camp must come with a copy of their current vaccination certificate.
- **Campsites are available at no extra cost.** Please indicate if you would like to camp and if you will be bringing a camper the size.
- **Adults are expected to stay with youth.**
