Entries must be postmarked or submitted to the 4-H office by June 1. Please enter each llama separately in all classes you are entering. **All entries must be identified by microchip (you must supply reader). Entries will not be accepted without microchipping!**

Non-ownership and copies of registration papers must be submitted with entry.

All llamas/alpacas must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with animals individually identified, proof of active immunization against rabies, and must be negative to an approved test appropriate to detect Bovine Viral Diarrhea persistent infection (BVD-PI). Do not send original certificates with entry form. Originals must accompany the animal.

Exhibitors shall be neat and clean wearing dress shirt and dark pants or skirt, closed toe shoes.

Judging will begin 8:00AM on Thursday.

Exhibitors may show multiple entries in one class unless otherwise stated. The additional entries must be shown by another 4-H exhibitor.

1. Senior – 14 to 19 years old.

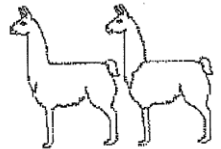

Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth legs

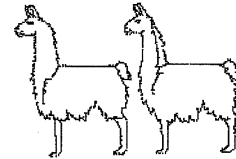
