Sullivan Renaissance is a beautification and community development program that offers a variety of grants designed to beautify public spaces, revitalize communities, and engage the diverse culture of Sullivan County. We are seeking to fill two part time / seasonal positions.

Sullivan Renaissance Horticulture Summer Assistants (“the crew”) work alongside project interns and community volunteers in support of Renaissance projects in Sullivan County. Duties include planting, renovating and maintaining gardens in public spaces that are funded through the Renaissance grant program. They report to and receive guidance from the Horticulture Coordinator.

Responsibilities:

- Clean up and prepare garden and project sites.
- Plant trees, shrubs, vines, perennials, grasses, annuals, bulbs.
- Mulch, apply compost and edge beds.
- Water, weed, fertilize and prune.
- Hand-water and monitor irrigation of plantings, especially during establishment and drought.
- Divide and transplant perennials.
- Clean up litter in and around planting beds.
- Scout for plant pests, diseases and/or damage and notify manager.
- Keep daily/weekly time sheets, site work and mileage records.
- Assist with special programs as needed.
- Assist with Intern and volunteer support as needed.
- Additional tasks as required.
