

4-H Livestock Auction Scholarship Application and Requirements

The Sullivan County 4-H Livestock Auction Program offers scholarships up to \$1,000 for 4-H youth pursuing secondary education. This may be two or four-year college, trade school, or certain certificate programs.

To be considered, the following criteria must be met.

- 1) Candidate must be a current 4-H member.
- 2) Candidate must be a high school senior.
- 3) Candidate needs to have a high school GPA of B or better, per report card or letter from school.
- 4) Candidate must have actively participated in the Sullivan County 4-H Livestock Program for at least 2 years. Applicants with 2 or more years' participation in the Livestock Auction will receive a bonus point for each year of participation.
- 5) Candidate should submit an about themselves, their interests, and educational goals. (No more than one, double-sided page please.)
- 6) A personal interview of candidates may be conducted before final selection. Based on availability of funds, more than one scholarship may be awarded. The committee may award scholarships at or below the amount requested.
- 7) Scholarship will be awarded upon satisfactory completion (C or better) of 1st semester of college. Official Transcripts must be submitted to the 4-H staff review.
