TEMPORARY POSITION JOB OPENING: Nutritionist 1 (Job Classification: Temporary Program Educator II)

Position- up to full time (37.5 hours/week; for 10-12 week appointment between 6/7/-8/29, 2018; Position is not benefit eligible; Pay- \$15/hour with reimbursement for approved travel according to CCE Association policies.

Primary Responsibilities: The Program Educator position will provide community nutrition education programs to improve healthy food and lifestyle choices among families and individuals encompassing targeted age groups throughout the County. Person is responsible to provide non-formal education using approved curricula and lesson plans to participants through group classes and at community/school sponsored events. Educational focus is on general nutrition, food preparation, food budgeting and food safety using USDA MyPlate guidelines. Informal education will be conducted in a variety of community and school settings, to include: workforce development agencies, youth-serving organizations, schools, Farmer's Markets, and edible garden sites.

As part of the Federal SNAP-Ed Regional, Eat Smart New York (ESNY) Program, this position works closely with the Community Nutrition Educator team under the supervision of the Supervising Nutritionist and the Project Manager. This position will collect and track data using approved methods following Association and University confidentiality protocol. The individual is expected to represent CCE in all interactions with staff, targeted audiences, community collaborators and the general public.

Qualifications- Required

Associate's Degree in the field of Nutrition, Health Education or Public Health **or equivalent coursework as part of a Bachelor's degree program** with 6 months of related volunteer or work experience.

Ability to work flexible hours which may include some evenings & weekends as position requires.

Ability to communicate effectively in both verbal and written communications.

Ability to meet local travel requirements associated with this position

Ability to meet acceptable background check standards.

Ability to work independently and as part of a team.

Ability to facilitate effective and relevant educational lessons to target audiences in group settings.

Qualifications- Preferred

Experience in adult and/or youth education or other relevant work experience

Familiarity with the community in which the work will take place

Experience working with the limited resource, culturally-diverse populations

Ability to plan and organize personal work responsibilities according to priorities developed with immediate supervisor.

Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing with Spanish-language speaking audiences

Proficient with basic Microsoft applications (Word/excel), Internet Navigation and current social media applications (e.g. Facebook and Twitter).
