To participate in Community Service Olympics, each youth or each club must keep a record of their work in a minimum of three of five service categories.

GOLD Award - Participation in 5 areas of service

SILVER Award - participation in 4 areas of service

BRONZE Award - participation in 3 areas of service

CLOVERBUD Award - for Cloverbuds participating in 3 or more areas of service

Check the category of service below and provide information as required below:

- Community/Government Service:** attend a government meeting, voter registration, painting fire hydrants, etc.
- Environmental Service:** community beautification projects, litter plucks, adopt-a-road, etc.
- Intergenerational Service:** visiting nursing homes, babysitting (i.e. for church or PTA programs), teaching an activity to a younger age group, etc.
- Wellness/Health and Fitness:** health fairs, walk-a-thons, relay fundraisers, etc.
- 4-H Program Service:** Youth Fair work nights/set-up day/clean-up, 4-H Interactive Booth (at Youth Fair or other public event), program promotion, etc.
