RULES AND PROCEDURES

- This competition is open to any amateur wine or cider maker, 21 years or older, who is a resident of New York State or Southern Ontario.
- Entry categories are shown above. Wines may be re-categorized at the judges' discretion.
- Each entry must include ONE bottle (24-26 oz. or 750ml). No bottles will be returned to the entrant. All entries become property of the Niagara County Fair.
- Each bottle must be identified with the maker's name, address, and category in which it was entered.
- An entry fee of \$5.00 is required for each entry; submit 3 entries, and the 4th entry is free.
- Entries must be dropped off or arrive by mail at CCE of Niagara County between July 16-23 by 4:30pm. Please note we will extend drop off hours on Tuesday July 17 only, from 8am-8pm.
- Packaging and shipping is the responsibility of the entrant.
- The WNY Home Wine Competition will not be responsible for lost or damaged bottles.
- The competition committee will decide questions on rules and procedures. All decisions rendered will be final.
- To enter, complete the form above, sign and date below, include entry form with the entry fee and bottle.
- Ribbons will be awarded to prize winners. All entries must be from home wine makers. No entries from wineries or from employees thereof will be considered.
