

Position Announcement (7/27/18)

Title: Two Generation Family and Community Educator

Summary: The Two Generation Family Educator is responsible for assisting in the development, delivery, and evaluation of educational programs in two generation parent and child programming. This position will be part of a program working at Cornell Cooperative Extension Tompkins County (CCETC) on the Institutional Challenge Grant, *Protecting Vulnerable Families and Children in the Crosshairs of the Opioid Epidemic: A Research-Practice Partnership in Upstate New York*, funded through the William T. Grant Foundation. This project will, in partnership with the Cornell Fellows, work closely with community partner agencies in order to gain first-hand experience in how to implement two generation parent and child programming, how to craft research agendas and products that are relevant to the community, and develop a replicable model for research/practice partnerships, with this position playing a key role in outreach to the community and direct education. This person will provide a strong connection between CCETC programs and initiatives and the communities they will impact.

Qualifications: Bachelor's Degree plus 4 years transferrable relevant evidence-based research experience or a Master's Degree. Experience with collaborative community work with families and community agencies. Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite. Ability to plan and organize work responsibilities according to priorities developed with the supervisor, Cornell Research Fellow, grant team, and clientele groups. Experience working with people of varying ages, socio-economic and diverse backgrounds.

Minimum Salary: \$19.00 - \$21.50 per hour

Hours/Benefits: Position is part-time (20 hours/week) and includes full benefit package including health and dental insurance, retirement, life insurance and more.
