He had the honor of racing in the Hambletonian Stakes, finishing 5th, and was sold at the end of 2006 and sent to Italy as a stud horse, where he still stands today. Now with the help of his family, John owns a smaller stable of 15 horses, mainly of 2 and 3 year old sire stakes horses.

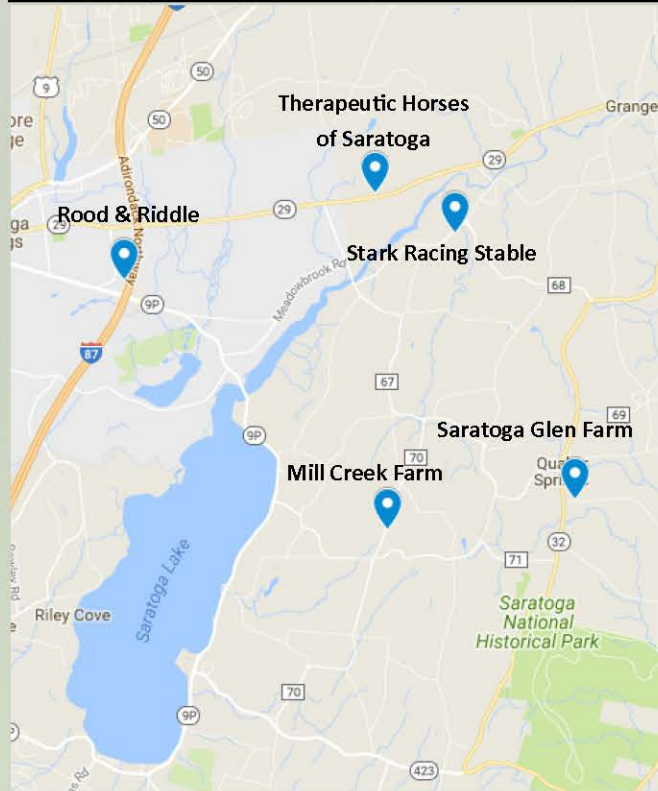
