	<i>Chick Feed</i>	Medicated feed for chicks after hatch. 4 Pound bag	\$4	
	<i>Shavings-Small Bag</i>	Wood bedding for floor of brooder box.	\$7	
	<i>Shavings-Bale</i>	Wood bedding for floor of brooder box. (Approx 4 times amount of small bag)	\$10

	<i>Incubator: GENESIS Hova-Bator 1588</i>	Pre-set digital thermostat, regulates itself. LCD displays temperature & humidity 18"x18"x 9.5", rounded square styrofoam w/ clear plastic top. Comes w/ plastic liner & wire floor.	\$142	
	<i>Incubator: Hova-Bator 1583</i>	Low cost alternative to 1588. Circulated air uses accurate & dependable wafer thermostat w/ picture window, plastic liner & wire floor 18.5"x18.5"x9.5"	\$112	
	<i>Egg Turner, automatic</i>	Automatically turns chicken eggs during incubation process. For Hova-Bator 1583 & 1588. (Write "QUAIL" in quantity box for quail racks.)	\$55	
	<i>Hova-Bator Plastic Liner</i>	Liner for bottom of Hova-Bator Incubator models 1583 and 1588. Keeps it clean & prevents leaks.	\$10	
	<i>Wire floor</i>	For bottom of Hova-Bator models 1583 and 1588.	\$7

	<i>Chick Water Dish, plastic (without jar)</i>	Provides adequate water & prevents drowning. Perfect for classroom set-up. Fits most jars.	\$5	
	<i>Chick Feeder, plastic (without jar)</i>	Provides adequate feed, limits contamination/ mess. 6" diameter. Perfect for classroom set-up.	\$7
