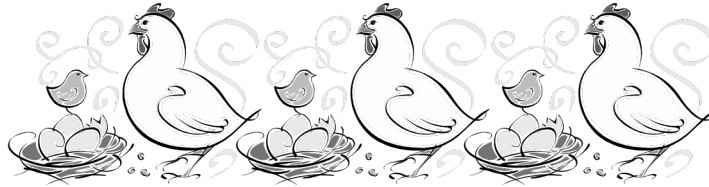


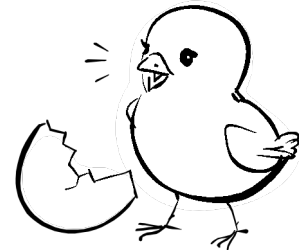
Chick Incubation & Embryology Teacher Training Workshops

Incubators, project supplies, and curriculum materials will be displayed and available for purchase during workshops.

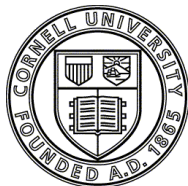
