

Transportation Educator

Responsibilities: Seeking a community facilitator and educator to foster transportation equity and sustainability across the county and region. The Transportation Educator will be part of the Way2Go team doing community mobility education by Cornell Cooperative Extension of Tompkins County. Way2Go's mission is to expand access to transportation by connecting people to existing options, and helping develop new community solutions. The selected candidate will engage a diverse range of community members and successfully employ an array of strategies to increase awareness of transportation options while promoting cultural change, policy change, and new service development.

Work includes facilitating dialogue and partnerships between transportation stakeholders and other sectors including housing, human services, health care, education and food, to highlight and engage transportation as a key social determinant of health.

Qualifications: Ability to initiate, plan, organize, implement, teach, and evaluate informal education programs. Attuned to different perspectives and possesses interpersonal skills that enable inclusivity. Demonstrates strong communication skills with the ability to use website media and social marketing to achieve program education goals. Ability to understand, interpret and apply research. Has knowledge or interest in local transportation issues. Bachelor's degree in public administration, planning, communication, education or related discipline with 4 years of transferrable relevant experience or a Master's degree in related discipline.

Starting rate for this position is \$18.00 per hour, with a higher level available based on experience.

Hours/Benefits: Position is full-time (40 hours/week) and includes full benefit package including health and dental insurance, retirement, life insurance and more. The position has flexible hours, with some possibility of working from home as part of the schedule.
